Terms and Conditions

(Last updated: June 30, 2026)

1. Preface

The DRAGON BALL LEGENDS WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP 2026-2027 tournament (hereafter referred to as the "Tournament") is managed and operated by Bandai Namco Entertainment Inc. (hereafter referred to as the "Organizer") and other companies contracted by the Organizer to assist with such responsibilities as part of the tournament administration group (hereafter referred to as the "Tournament Administration"). By participating in the Tournament, you agree to these terms and conditions (hereafter referred to as the "Conditions"). The Tournament Administration reserves the right to decide on all points outlined in these Conditions or in the separate "DRAGON BALL LEGENDS WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP 2026-2027 Tournament Rules" (hereafter referred to as the "Tournament Rules"), as well as on points not outlined therein or in cases where their application would result in a considerably unfair outcome.

2. Participation Requirements

All of the following participation requirements must be fulfilled in order to participate in the Tournament (participating players will hereinafter be referred to as "Participants").

- 1) Fully read and understand and agree to these Conditions and the Tournament Rules. Participating in the Tournament by using the ticket(s) to compete in the "LEGENDS BATTLE ROYAL" preliminary events within DRAGON BALL LEGENDS will be considered as consent to these Conditions and Tournament Rules.
- 2) Create an account (free registration) for the external "Bandai Namco ID" service provided and operated by the Organizer, and set up "Data Transfer Settings" within DRAGON BALL LEGENDS using that Bandai Namco ID.

- 3) If you qualify for the SUMMER/AUTUMN Preliminary 2nd STAGE and FINALS outlined in the Tournament Rules, you must complete the registration via the entry form.
- 4) Be at least eighteen (18) years of age or the age of majority in your country, state, and region of residence (whichever is older) by the time you enter the SUMMER/AUTUMN Preliminary 2nd STAGE. Furthermore, whether a Participant fulfills the participation requirements for each 2nd STAGE shall be determined based on their age at the time of entry to that respective 2nd STAGE.
*Age-related participation requirements are determined separately for each 2nd STAGE. Even if a player fails to meet the age requirement when entering the SUMMER Preliminary 2nd STAGE, they can still participate in the AUTUMN Preliminary 2nd STAGE as long as the age requirement is met at the time of entry.
- 5) The Tournament FINALS will take place on February 6, 2027, and the period required by the Tournament Administration for activities, including rehearsals, will be from February 4 to February 5, 2027. Participants must be able to attend rehearsals, photoshoots, player orientations, and other activities in accordance with the schedule specified by the Tournament Administration.
Furthermore, Participants' length of stay in Japan will be determined based on their place of residence as follows:
 - ▼ Participants residing outside of Japan (JST)
Must arrive in Japan on February 3, 2027 and depart Japan on February 7, 2027. The period of stay will be from February 3 to February 7, 2027.
 - ▼ Participants residing in Japan (JST)
Participate in accordance with the schedule specified by the Tournament Administration from February 4 to February 7, 2027.
- 6) Be able to participate in the FINALS and other related events at the FINALS venue, located in Tokyo (If a Participant qualifies for the FINALS, they must hold a valid passport permitting entry into Japan by the time the FINALS entry procedures begin and, if necessary, obtain a visa to enter Japan).
- 7) Be able to use the transportation methods (public transportation such as airplanes, bullet trains, and trains) specified by the Tournament Administration.
- 8) Be able to stay in the accommodations (hotel) specified by the Tournament Administration.

*The Tournament Administration will not be responsible for arranging travel and accommodation, nor provide any other assistance, for anyone accompanying those participating in the Tournament (relatives, caregivers, attendants, etc.).

- 9) Be able to communicate with the Tournament Administration and other Participants in at least one of the following languages: Japanese, English, Korean, Chinese (Traditional), French, German, Spanish, Portuguese or have a representative be able to communicate in any of these languages.
- 10) Be able to receive and respond to communications sent by the Tournament Administration in accordance with the schedule.

*Communication from the Tournament Administration will be mainly sent via a Discord chat (<https://discord.com/>).

- 11) Consent to the following: Participants are responsible for managing their personal belongings for the entire duration of the Tournament. The Tournament Administration will not be held responsible for any loss or damage to any of the Participant's personal belongings in any way.
- 12) Understand and follow these Conditions and the Tournament Rules.
- 13) Provide personal information, including name, age, and address, to the Tournament Administration for the Tournament, and consent to being photographed, recorded, and/or reported on by the Tournament Administration and media outlets.
- 14) Consent to the use of all information related to the Participant's DRAGON BALL LEGENDS gameplay during each step of the Tournament (including but not limited to match results and characters used) on the official website, on social media, and in broadcasts (including livestreams).
- 15) Consent to the broadcast (including livestreaming), reporting, and/or use (for all purposes, including commercial ones) of your likeness, name and tournament nickname, age, statements, and actions as depicted in tournament recordings, as well as the content of your matches (including gameplay), by the Tournament Administration and third parties designated by the Tournament Administration (such as media outlets or tournament sponsors) in media, including on television, in newspapers, on the official website, and on social media, without limit and compensation (i.e. you will not exercise any rights pertaining to your likeness or right of publicity).

- 16) Present a personal identification with your name that can be used to verify your identity at the venue or on arrival at the hotel on the day of the FINALS. Participants who are not Japanese citizens must present their valid passport. Participants who are Japanese citizens may use any of the original documents (copies will not be accepted) as detailed below to verify its identity.

- Documents Valid for Personal Identification (Any 1)

- *Only valid with picture identification

- *Copies will not be accepted. Only original documents are valid.

- [1] My Number Card (the Notification Card is not valid)

- [2] Driver's license

- [3] Passport

- [4] Basic Resident Registration Card

- [5] Disability certificate (Physical Disability Certificate, Rehabilitation Certificate, or Health and Welfare Handbook for the Mentally Disabled)

- [6] Residence Card, Foreign Resident Registration Card, or Special Permanent Resident Certificate

- [7] International driver's license

- Documents Valid for Personal Identification (Any 2)

- *Two of the following must be presented.

- *Copies will not be accepted. Only original documents are valid.

- [1] Health insurance card

- [2] Seal Registration Certificate (the registered seal must also be presented)

- [3] Company identification with photograph

- [4] Other form of identification with photograph issued by a government institution

<About My Number Cards>

- When presenting your My Number Card as a form of personal identification, please ensure that only the front side with the photograph is visible. Do not show the back side which displays your individual number.

*The Notification Card (the paper card with your individual number printed on it, but without a photograph) for your My Number Card cannot be used as a personal identification.

Copies of your personal identification documents, expired personal identification documents, and documents not listed above will not be accepted.

- 17) Your tournament nickname will not include words or phrases that are inappropriate or would infringe upon the rights of a third party. The Organizer reserves the right to decline to accept any nickname(s) that violates this section.
- 18) Understand that Participants may be disqualified in the event they are deemed unfit to continue competing by the Tournament Administration due to poor health or other circumstances.
- 19) Participants, as well as their relatives, must not be a part of or involved with anti-social forces (gangs or criminal syndicates, including their associate members and related corporations, corporate blackmail rings, racketeer groups acting under the guise of social or political movements, other specialized organized crime groups, or any group equivalent to these groups).
- 20) Regardless of the Tournament period, the accounts of those who have entered the Tournament must have no previous in-game penalties in "DRAGON BALL LEGENDS", and their game records must not contain any inappropriate entries, including those resulting from cheating (including but not limited to accessing unauthorized parts of the game, achieving results, scores, or other metrics that cannot be obtained under normal gameplay conditions provided by the Organizer, using bots, emulators, or other unauthorized third-party tools), that deviate from the scope of normal gameplay results (game records will be reviewed by the Tournament Administration upon advancement for each preliminary (SUMMER/AUTUMN/EXTRA STAGE) prior to the FINALS).
- 21) Are not involved in any behavior prohibited by Bandai Namco Entertainment Inc., are not violating the in-game Terms of Service (<https://legal.bandainamcoent.co.jp/terms/?lang=en>), and have not had your account suspended.

3. Tournament Entry/Participation

As outlined in Section 5, "Tournament Schedule", of the Tournament Rules, the SUMMER/AUTUMN Preliminary 1st STAGE, SUMMER/AUTUMN Preliminary 2nd STAGE,

EXTRA STAGE Preliminary, and FINALS can be entered by following the procedures below. Participants must meet the provisions described in the tournament process for each stage and fulfill the requirements described in Section 2, "Participation Requirements", of these Conditions.

*"LEGENDS BATTLE ROYAL" is an in-game event held within "DRAGON BALL LEGENDS". Even if a player achieves the performance equivalent to the qualifying conditions stated for "LEGENDS BATTLE ROYAL", failure to fulfill Section 2, "Participation Requirements", of these Conditions will result in the Participant not being eligible to qualify for the SUMMER/AUTUMN Preliminary 1st STAGE, or the EXTRA STAGE Preliminary, and shall result in the forfeiture of their right to advance to the SUMMER/AUTUMN Preliminary 2nd STAGE and the FINALS.

● SUMMER/AUTUMN Preliminary 1st STAGE

Participation in this tournament stage requires playing "LEGENDS BATTLE ROYAL".

Entry Tickets will be distributed to all players who, by the "Entry Deadlines" set for the SUMMER/AUTUMN Preliminary 1st STAGE, have set up "Data Transfer Settings" with a Bandai Namco ID and have unlocked the PvP Rating Match game mode by clearing up through Part 1, Book 7, Chapter 6 of the Main Story of DRAGON BALL LEGENDS.

● SUMMER/AUTUMN Preliminary 2nd STAGE

Online tournaments will be held among Participants who cleared the SUMMER/AUTUMN Preliminary 1st STAGE. There will be a total of three tournaments held, one for each server (1. Japan/Asia/Oceania, 2. Europe/Africa, and 3. North/South America). Participants can compete one time only in the tournament for the server they play on. To compete, Participants must meet all of the following provisions.

- Complete entry for the SUMMER/AUTUMN Preliminary 2nd STAGE according to the entry process at the direction of the Tournament Administration.
- Join the Discord server used for communications related to the Tournament.
- Use the tournament organization tool start.gg (<https://www.start.gg/>) used for running the SUMMER/AUTUMN Preliminary 2nd STAGE.

- Fulfill the other requirements described in Section 2, "Participation Requirements", of these Conditions.

● **EXTRA STAGE Preliminary**

Participation in this tournament stage requires playing "LEGENDS BATTLE ROYAL".

Entry Tickets will be distributed to all players who, by the "Entry Deadlines" set for the EXTRA STAGE Preliminary, have set up "Data Transfer Settings" with a Bandai Namco ID and have unlocked the PvP Rating Match game mode by clearing up through Part 1, Book 7, Chapter 6 of the Main Story of DRAGON BALL LEGENDS.

● **FINALS**

The FINALS is an 8-player offline tournament featuring 3 players who cleared the SUMMER Preliminary 2nd Stage, 3 players who cleared the AUTUMN Preliminary 2nd STAGE, and 2 players who cleared the EXTRA STAGE Preliminary. It will be held in Tokyo, Japan. To compete, Participants must meet all of the following provisions.

- Complete entry for the FINALS according to the entry process at the direction of the Tournament Administration.
- Be able to participate in-person at the FINALS venue (within Tokyo). That is, they must have a valid passport and, if necessary, obtain a visa for entering Japan in accordance with the tournament schedule by December 4, 2026 (UTC).

*Residents of Japan are not required to obtain or hold a valid passport.

Other Important Notes:

- 1) Except at the request of the Tournament Administration, changes to registered information will not be accepted after entry is completed.
- 2) Entry Tickets for the SUMMER/AUTUMN Preliminary 1st STAGE will be distributed sequentially to each account.
- 3) Tournament participation is free. Participants in the FINALS will have the necessary travel expenses and lodging fees accommodated for the duration of the FINALS by the Organizer. Travel expenses include travel between each Participant's nearest airport to the venue and the hotel designated by the Organizer (the "Design

ated Hotel”). For domestic Participants who will not be flying, travel expenses will instead include travel to and from each Participant's nearest train station and to the venue. All seats will be economy class. Participants are responsible for any costs incurred by i) staying in Japan longer than the number of days deemed necessary to participate in the FINALS as determined by the Tournament Administration, or ii) using any transportation method not designated by the Tournament Administration. The Participant will be responsible for any other expenses not specified herein.

*Participants will require a credit card to check-in at the Designated Hotel and will be responsible to cover any additional costs incurred during their stay. On the day of the FINALS, Participants will be required to bring the personal identification prepared separately by the Organizer. If Participants decide to stay anywhere outside of the Designated Hotel, such Participant is responsible for all related fees and must ensure they prepare the necessary visa and other arrival documents.

- 4) Even if the ranking and qualification requirements in the SUMMER/AUTUMN Preliminary 2nd STAGE are met, participation in the FINALS shall not be guaranteed at that time. Entry interviews will be held (via video chat, etc.) to ensure that all players who qualify for the FINALS fulfill the requirements outlined in these Conditions. If, as a result of the interview, it is determined that a player does not meet the participation requirements set forth in these Conditions, or if it is found that a player provided false information regarding the participation requirements, violated these Conditions, or acted in a manner otherwise deemed inappropriate by the Tournament Administration, that player will be disqualified. In case of a disqualification, an alternate will be selected in accordance with the rankings and criteria determined by the Tournament Administration to take their place as a FINALS Participant.

4. Recording/Streaming

- 1) The Tournament Administration reserves the right to record and edit, to stream and archive on multiple platforms, to broadcast on television, and to use for other similar purposes, footage of the Tournament, individual matches (including gameplay), and individual player performances. This extends to third parties with the permission of the Tournament Administration.

- 2) Participants recognize that the usage of FINALS footage (including footage of the venue, as well as videos playing at the venue, official livestreams, and other footage released by the Tournament Administration), in whole or in part (including for "mirror streams"), without approval by parties other than the Participant and Tournament Administration may constitute copyright infringement and/or a violation of an individual's likeness and other legal rights. Participants further agree to not commit such acts. For the SUMMER/AUTUMN 1st STAGE and SUMMER/AUTUMN 2nd STAGE, matches may be streamed in accordance with the Bandai Namco Entertainment Video Policy (<https://www.bandainamcoent.co.jp/english/video-policy/>).

5. Prizes

Participants will receive prizes for the Tournament as follows:

- Champion (1 Participant)
 - Chrono Crystal Display
 - Champion Trophy
- TOP 8 (Including Champion)
 - Award Plaque
 - Uniform, T-shirt
 - Original In-Game Items, etc.

*Subject to change for operational reasons. Prizes may not be transferred, exchanged for other prizes or exchanged for cash. However, at the sole discretion of the Organizer, any prize may be substituted for one of equal or greater value. It is expressly forbidden to sell the prizes.

6. Prohibited Behavior

Participants must not commit any of the following acts. Our Code of Conduct (<https://legal.bandainamcoent.co.jp/terms/codeofconduct>) will also apply to the Tournament. In the event that, at the Tournament, a Participant engages in unfair conduct, violates these Conditions, the Tournament Rules, the game's Terms of Service, or the Code of Conduct, or refuses to comply with the directions of tournament staff, et

c., the Organizer reserves the right to disqualify that Participant, remove them from the Tournament venue, and take other necessary measures.

- 1) Violation of these Conditions or the Tournament Rules.
- 2) Arrive late at the reception for the Tournament or fail to arrive at a designated time or location.
- 3) Refuse to comply with any directions and/or requests from tournament staff necessary to the operation of the Tournament.
- 4) Intentionally hinder the Tournament Administration or the operation of the Tournament.
- 5) Repeatedly contact the Tournament Administration, Discord administrators, or other tournament-related personnel via direct messages, social media, or any other communication methods not designated by the Tournament Administration.
- 6) Repeatedly submit inquiries, opinions, requests, and other similar messages regarding the Tournament through channels and methods other than those designated by the Tournament Administration.
- 7) Dispute decisions regarding eligibility, disqualification, ranking, and other rulings made by the Tournament Administration through methods other than those designated in the Tournament Rules.
- 8) Damage the reputation or image of the Tournament Administration, Participants, a third party, or the game itself. Commit violent, disruptive, or harassing acts.
- 9) Intentionally submit false information during the entry process.
- 10) Reveal internal information related to the Tournament Administration (correspondence with the Tournament Administration, etc.) or the personal information of other Participants without written permission of the Tournament Administration.
- 11) Leave or withdraw from the Tournament after it has begun without permission from the Tournament Administration.
- 12) Fail to appropriately answer questions from the Tournament Administration necessary to the operation of the Tournament or providing false information to the Tournament Administration.

- 13) Communicate with a third party other than an opponent or the Tournament Administration during a match without permission from the Tournament Administration or receive match advice from such a party.
- 14) Exploit the game in a way unintended by the developers to gain an advantage, collude with other Participants in order to gain an advantage in the Tournament, or inappropriately provoke an opponent.
- 15) Speak or act in an offensive manner or use a username in-game that is offensive.
- 16) Infringe upon the intellectual property, personality, privacy, or other legal rights of the Tournament Administration or a third party, or damage their reputation or interests.
- 17) Transfer or sell the right to participate in the Tournament, the travel expenses or accommodation fees, or the right to receive prizes to a third party.
- 18) Enter or participate in the Tournament using multiple accounts.
- 19) Use the Tournament for commercial purposes.
- 20) Allow anti-social forces or related parties to participate.
- 21) Participate in the Tournament wearing excessively disheveled clothing or clothing deemed inappropriate by the Tournament Administration.
- 22) Act in a manner otherwise deemed inappropriate by the Tournament Administration.

7. Handling of Violations

Participants understand that, if the Tournament Administration determines a Participant has violated these Conditions, depending on the type and severity of the violation, such as through editing or deleting registered information, the Tournament Administration may take disciplinary action, including but not limited to disqualification from the Tournament, requiring reimbursement of travel expenses and accommodation fees, removal of titles and prizes, invalidation of entry, or a ban from competing. We reserve the right to seek appropriate compensation for accommodation fees, travel expenses, cancellation fees, and other kinds of damages that may arise as a result of taking appropriate disciplinary action.

The Tournament Administration will take the necessary measures outlined in these Conditions and the Tournament Rules if it determines that the fairness or integrity of

f the Tournament has been compromised. No detailed explanation of the measures taken will be provided even upon individual inquiry.

8. Handling of Personal Information

- 1) Participants consent to the editing, publication, sharing, broadcast (including livestreaming), reporting, or use (for all purposes, including commercial ones) of their likeness, name and tournament nickname, age, statements, and actions as depicted in tournament recordings, as well as the content of their matches (including gameplay), by the Tournament Administration and third parties designated by the Tournament Administration (such as media outlets or tournament sponsors) in various media, including but not limited to on YouTube or other online video platforms, on television, in newspapers, on websites, on social media, or in pamphlets without limit and without compensation. Participants further agree that they will not exercise any rights pertaining to their likeness or right of publicity).
- 2) Personal information collected from Participants during entry for this Tournament will be used for operating, managing, and publicizing the Tournament. This personal information will be managed in accordance with the separate Bandai Namco Entertainment Privacy Policy (<https://legal.bandainamcoent.co.jp/privacy/?lang=en>).

9. Disclaimers

- 1) We reserve the right to change the particulars of the Tournament or participating regions, as well as suspend, delay, or cancel it, due to our own circumstances; due to an earthquake, tsunami, flood, fire, infectious disease, act of terrorism, war, rioting, or equipment failure; due to a law, a judicial decree, decision, or order, or other legally binding government measure that would prevent the Tournament from continuing; or due to any other force majeure. The Tournament Administration will not be held responsible for any damages that might occur as a result of any of these circumstances that are beyond its control. In the event of a change to the particulars of the Tournament or participating regions, or of its suspension, delay, or cancellation, that information will be shared in a manner we deem appropriate, such as through our official social media accounts or an in-game notice. Please note that circumstances may prevent us from paying the tra

vel expenses and/or accommodation fees of FINALS participants and alternates or force us to request that those expenses and/or fees be returned or reimbursed.

- 2) The Tournament Administration will not be held responsible for any damages that arise from a Participant being disqualified while competing in the Tournament due to a violation of these Conditions or unfair conduct. Furthermore, the Tournament Administration reserves the right to determine whether behavior is in violation of these Conditions or is considered unfair conduct.
- 3) Participants who are in poor health, have abnormal blood pressure, have a heart condition, have experienced convulsions or fainting due to visual stimuli in the past, or who have a pacemaker should participate at their own risk.
- 4) The Tournament Administration will not be held responsible in the unlikely event that Participants incur losses or damages (including but not limited to financial damages) as a result of participating or not participating in the Tournament, or as a result of the Tournament being livestreamed or broadcast, or not livestreamed or broadcast. Each Participant acknowledges that they are participating in the tournament at their own risk and shall bear all such responsibilities themselves.
- 5) Except when caused by directions given by the Tournament Administration or by its handling of a situation, whether intentionally or as a result of gross negligence, the Tournament Administration will not be held responsible for damages to Participants or alternates (and their related parties) that arise during the Tournament, or while Participants or alternates are traveling to or staying within Japan to participate in the FINALS. This includes damages from accidents or other incidents; violating these Conditions; issues or failures with tournament equipment, software, or network facilities; or any other issues related to the Tournament's operations.
- 6) Participants are responsible for managing their personal belongings for the entire duration of the Tournament. The Tournament Administration will not be held responsible for those belongings should they be lost or stolen, or in the event of some kind of accident.
- 7) The Tournament Administration shall not be liable for any disputes that arise between Participants or for any damages or losses due to the Participant's violation

n of the Conditions, except in cases where the Tournament Administration bears significant responsibility in the instructions or handling of the Tournament.

10. About the Use of Participant Likeness

Participants consent to the use by the company and third parties designated by the company of photographs, videos, audio recordings, and other images or recorded data, including the Participant's player name, likeness, name, tournament nickname, team name, and team gameplay (hereafter referred to as "User-Generated Content") on a perpetual basis, without compensation. The company may use User-Generated Content for the Tournament's operations, as well as for the company's marketing and promotional activities (including but not limited to video sharing platforms such as YouTube, on television, in newspapers, on the official website, on social media, and in pamphlets), and for any other purpose. Additionally, you hereby waive any and all legal claims they currently have or may acquire arising from the company's use of the User-Generated Content.

11. Applicable Laws and Jurisdiction

These Conditions are subject to Japanese law. In the event legal action becomes necessary due to these Conditions, the Tokyo District Court will have exclusive jurisdiction as the court of first instance.

12. Amendments to the Terms and Conditions/Tournament Rules

The Tournament Administration reserves the right to amend these Conditions and the Tournament Rules without notice at its sole discretion. Any amendments will be posted on the official website for this Tournament.
